#### CONSULTANT'S PRESENTATION

Mr. Ronald Smeal presented the Draft of a report entitled A STUDY OF THE STAFFING, MANAGEMENT, BUDGET, ADMINISTRATION AND FUNDING FORMULA OF THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL POLICE DEPARTMENT.
